Mr Wong is Chief Executive of The Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation Ltd. He is a Group Managing Director and a member of the Group Management Board of HSBC Holdings plc.

Mr Wong's banking career began in 1980 when he joined Citibank. He joined Standard Chartered Bank in 1997. He joined HSBC in 2005. From April 2005 to January 2010, he was Group General Manager and Executive Director, Hong Kong and Mainland China of HSBC, before assuming his current position in February 2010.

Mr Wong serves on a number of government and regulatory advisory bodies: he is a member of the Exchange Fund Advisory Committee of the Hong Kong Monetary Authority, a member of the HKSAR Economic Development Commission and a member of the Aviation Development Advisory Committee. In mainland China, Mr Wong is a member of the 12th Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference, a member of the 10th and 11th Hubei provincial committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference, an International Adviser to the Mayor of Tianjin, a member of the Mayor of Chongqing's International Economic Advisory Council, Vice President of the China Banking Association (“CBA”) Standing Council and Director of the CBA Board, and a Standing Committee Member of the Red Cross Society of China.
